The Club also presented the Peter Lacey Medal to BMD Northcliffe's Megan Kreuter - Most Outstanding Under 17 competitor of the Queensland State Surf Life Saving Championships and on hand to present the award was Carbine Club stalwart and Surf Life Saving 'icon' Max Christmas, pictured right with Megan

Megan and Kurt each received medals and \$5000.00 cheques to support them in furthering their sporting careers and ambitions.
