OBITUARY

Dudley Storey OBE



Olympic rowing gold medallist Dudley Storey died on 6th March 2017 aged 77 having recently been diagnosed with Motor Neuron disease. He was a member of the New Zealand crew that won gold in the coxed four at the 1968 Mexico Olympic Games and won silver in the coxless fours at the 1972 Munich Olympic Games. He then became national rowing coach of the New Zealand eights that won back to back gold medals at the 1982 and 1983 World Championships and manager of Olympic and Commonwealth Games teams. He was made an Officer of the Order of the British Empire in 1983 for his services to rowing. His contribution to rowing was enormous and he will be greatly missed. A celebration of Dudley's life is to take place at The Don Rowlands Centre, Lake Karapiro at a later date.
