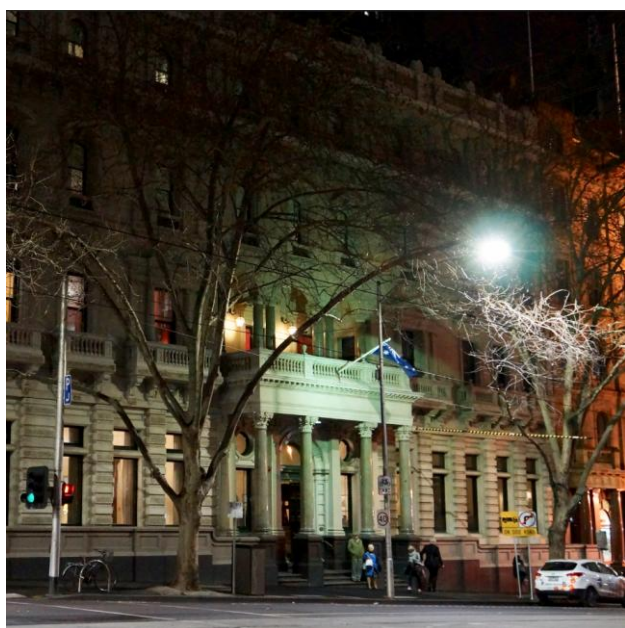

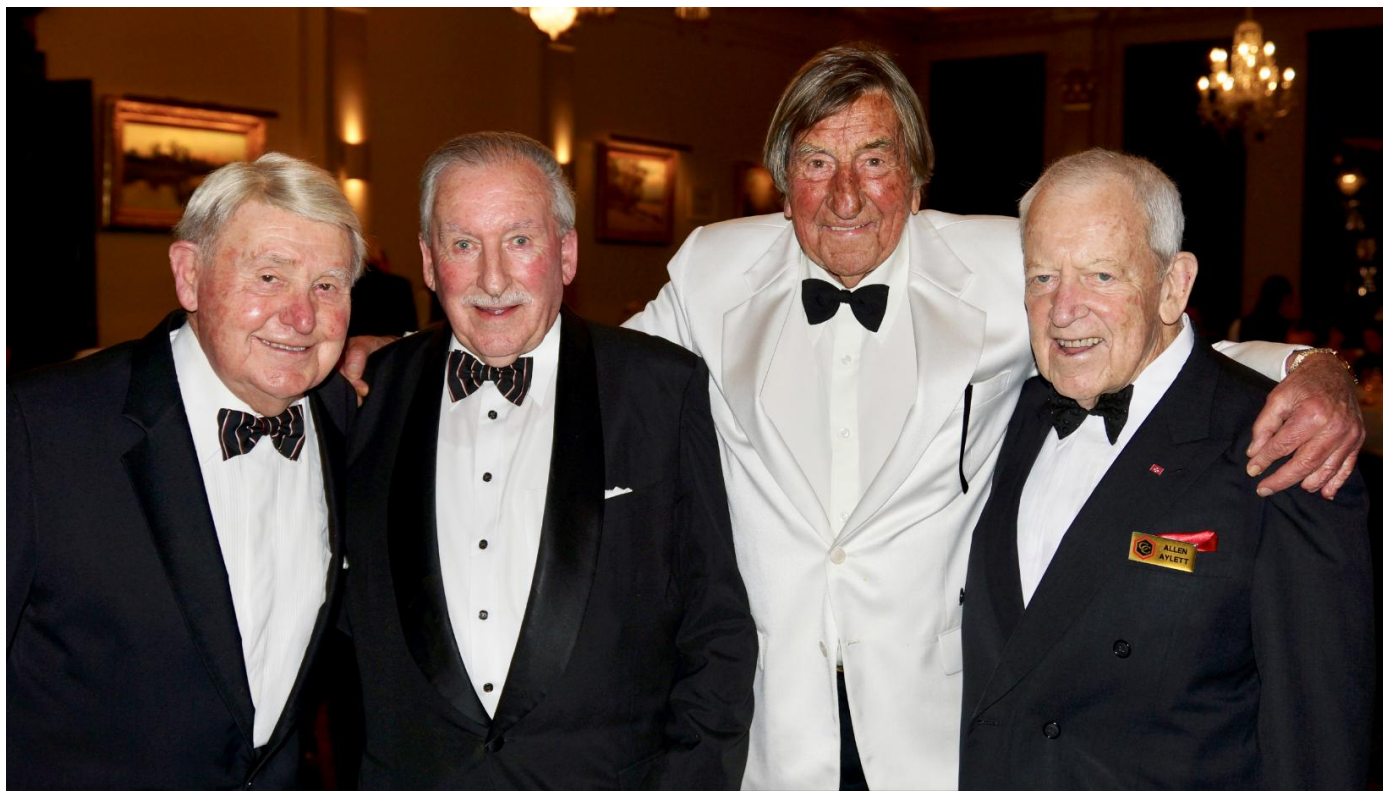
CC Delegates from Australia & overseas joined members of The Carbine Club for the traditional Annual Dinner at The Australian Club, in late July.

The Carbine Club of Singapore was treated to a very unique four hours of entertainment with special guests John Sylvester and Jobe Watson both commanding near absolute silence in the room as they told their respective stories. John, who is senior crime reporter for The Age, delivered a revealing random walk through the criminal networks that operate in Australia and the kingpins behind them.
