OUR CONGRATULATIONS TO PEGGY O'NEAL AND FRANK SEDGMAN

Carbine Club member Peggy O'Neal who is the first woman to serve as President of an AFL Club (Richmond FC President since 2013) has been recognised in the Queen's Birthday Honours.

Peggy was awarded an Officer in the Order of Australia (AO) in recognition of her distinguished service to Australian Rules Football, to superannuation and finance law, and to the advancement of women in leadership roles.





Frank Sedgman

Club Member Frank Sedgman was also elevated to the rank of Officer in the Order of Australia (AO) in further recognition of his brilliant career where he was a Wimbledon and Davis Cup champion, taking just 5 years to amass 22 major titles and at his peak in 1951-52 he won 16 major titles.

A pioneer of the professional circuit, Frank was a mentor and coach who set a high standard for behaviour on and off the court and his latest award recognises Frank "as a role model for young sportspersons."







Carbine Club of Hong Kong - Donating to Charity


June has been a satisfying month for the Hong Kong Chapter with Club President Mark Winstanley taking part in two separate presentation ceremonies for our long time chosen charities: Hong Kong Rugby Union Community Foundation (HKRUCF) and The Riding for the Disabled Association (RDA)


The first event took place on 8th June 2019 at a lunch hosted by the RDA during which the Carbine Club of Hong Kong presented a cheque for HK\$ 251,403 (AU\$ 47,000). This represents the donations raised at the CCHK International Racing Lunch held in December 2018. This donation will help the RDA in Hong Kong to achieve its aims of teaching disabled children and some adults to ride a horse to the best of their ability. Riding is widely recognized as one of the most beneficial forms of therapy the disabled can receive. Riding builds self-confidence, improves concentration and self-discipline and at the same time, provides recreation and sport.

The second event took place on 15th June 2019. The CCHK presented a cheque for HK\$ 240,000 (AU\$ 44,000) to Rhys Blumberg, Head of HKRUCF during the half time break of the Hong Kong v Malaysia Asian Rugby Championship match at the Hong Kong Football Club. The donation represented fund raising proceeds from the CCHK Rugby 7s Lunch in early April. The HKRUCF are using rugby and the Hong Kong Rugby Union brand to bring about positive change within the Hong Kong community by tackling social issues around inclusive society, education programs and improving health and wellbeing in our communities. The funds raised at the Rugby 7s Lunch will be used by HKRUCF to support their education programs aimed at helping underprivileged Hong Kong kids with ADHD.

A note of special thanks from CCHK goes out to CC members from all chapters who have attended our lunches and for their contributions in supporting the great work that RDA and HKRUCF are doing in Hong Kong.
