Nick poignantly reminded guests of the importance of placing sporting endeavour in the appropriate context. The first guest speaker of the afternoon



was former rookie of the year and test playing Wallaby Julian Huxley. Julian suffered a brain tumour and was lost to professional rugby for some time. His story about returning to play for the Melbourne Rebels was an inspirational account of a long road back to health.

Anthony Herbert took the stage after lunch and entertained the crowd with some of the lighter moments of touring as a Wallaby International. Stories of his fund-raising skill in the era of amateur rugby had the room in fits of laughter. 
