

Sponsorship cheque presentations of \$25,000, had been made earlier to VIS representatives by the Committee.






All this was preceded earlier in the month, with the traditional Incoming/Outgoing President's dinner, in the convivial environs of the Cellar Room at The


President elect, Rod Fitzroy was acknowledged as an extremely worthy successor & takes over the helm with the full support of the Committee & members. He will do a great job.


