Three hundred members and guests gathered at the Gateway Hotel – the second home of the Carbine Club in PNG- for the SP Hunters Rugby League Lunch, the Club's first lunch for the year and the first under new President Stan Joyce CSM.

Stan was wearing two hats on the day as he is also the General Manager of the South Pacific Brewery (SP), the major sponsor of the lunch. In his welcome speech Stan thanked VIPs, the chairman of PNGRL Mr.Sandis Tsaka, the Chairman of SP Brewery Mr. Joe Tauvasa and last but not least, the Past Patron of the Carbine Club of PNG Mr.Bart Philemon, still a great supporter of our club.

Carbine Club PNG Committeeman Brent St. Hill as usual had done his extensive research and enlightened on the backgrounds of both speakers: Royce Simmons of the Sydney Penrith Panthers NRL fame who captained them to the club's first ever premiership, and Melbourne based comedian Des Dowling.

Both speakers had been to PNG previously, Royce as a player with the Kangaroos and as coach of Penrith Panthers when they played the Brisbane Broncos in an exhibition match at Port Moresby's Hubert Murray Stadium in the 90's.

Des was in PNG last year in Lae at the Scrum Rugby Union Lunch and mentioned that he still remembers the drive from the airport to the hotel with Carbine Club member Tyno and that he will never know how he or pedestrians on the side of the road survived—an experience he will never forget. But then, both our speakers knew what to expect: "in the land of the unexpected!"

Rod read out the names of the players in the inaugural international Kumul team and spoke of their achievements in their careers and highlighted those players who have contributed in promoting the game since.

Yet again an inspirational and enlightening talk by Rod who resides overseas in Cairns and who travels up for every Carbine Club function without fail and has done for many years.

Superb kai (food) was served by the host hotel the Gateway and the refreshments kept on coming. SP Brewery as usual made sure the cold amber fluid kept flowing and the Gateway staff excelled in the service area.
