Last year, the funds raised at the annual Charity Golf tournament and other funds raised through the year resulted in a total of \$29,000 being paid to these two organisations. These funds were applied partly in scholarships to athletes working towards the 2020 Paralympic Games. The remainder of the funds were used to purchase sports equipment for junior athletes and to developing Para Swimming and Athletics training programmes designed to produce future generations of Paralympians. The donations made to these organisations, and in particular, the athletes, are very much appreciated.

The Club, through the Sir Denis Blundell Charitable Trust, is aiming to increase its contributions to these two organisations next year. Please assist us to do so.
