

It's An Honour.....



CCACT Special Member Ricky Stuart became a member of the Order of Australia in the recent Queen's Birthday Honours List. Coach of the Canberra Raiders, Ricky was honoured for his significant service to rugby league and the community especially through the Ricky Stuart Foundation which he established with his wife to raise support for autism and to assist with the provision of carers and family support. Ricky's career in League is legendary –a dual code international he also played state of Origin for NSW and was a member of the premiership winning Canberra Raiders in '89,'90 and '94.

CCSA Member Joe Stevens received an Order of Australia Medal for his services to athletics.

Joe began his involvement in athletics at home in South Australia with Catholic Collegians United Athletics

Club (now United Collegians) in the early seventies as a sprinter and shot putter. He returned in a more formal way as an official in 1998 when his son took up the sport. Joe has been there ever since – as a member of Western Athletic Club (formerly Western Districts Athletic Club). He was named Athletics South Australia Official of the Year in 2003 – 2004.

Joe is a Life member of Athletics Australia, president of the state division of the Commonwealth Games Association and a former president of the South Australian Olympic Council. He is also race director of the City-Bay Fun Run (since 2004) and previous awards include Official of the Year for Athletics Australia in 2010 and the same award for Athletics SA in 2003.

Much to the surprise of all, particularly the recipients, special recognition was made of club Senior Members Reg Cannon and Des Morris- Des was a recent OAM recipient, well deserved and noted elsewhere in this bulletin.

Accolades were showered upon them by the George Doniger in a style reminiscent of the days when he joined CCQLD stalwart, Mick Veivers, in the trail blazing days of TV's "Match of the Day" from 1970 to 1978. Reg Cannon was renowned as a superb "eighty-minute-player" in the 1960s with Brisbane Wests then Brothers where there were two premierships. Reg played eleven matches for Queensland in those pre-State of Origin times.
