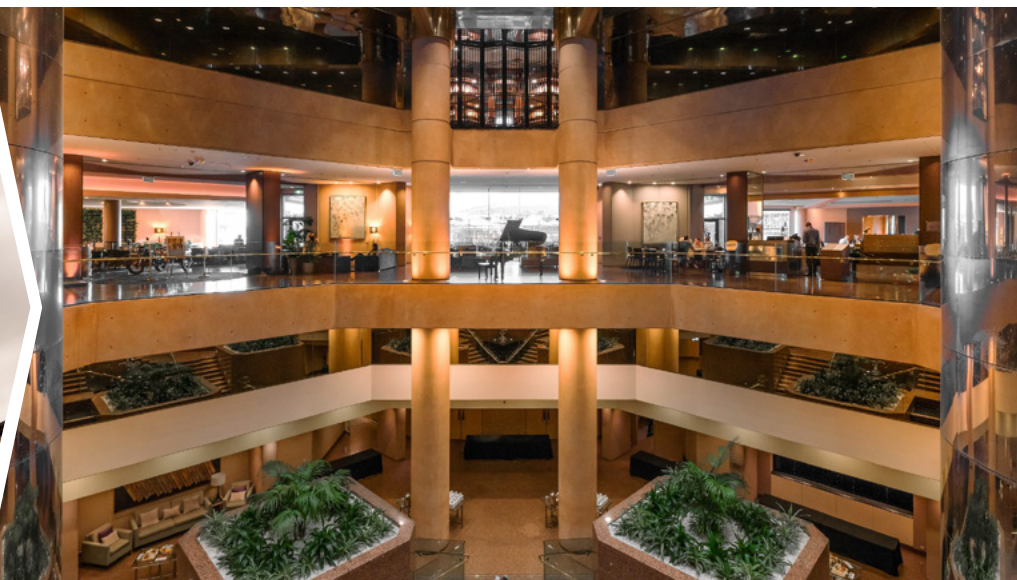
OUR CONGRESS HOTEL INTERCONTINENTAL ADELAIDE

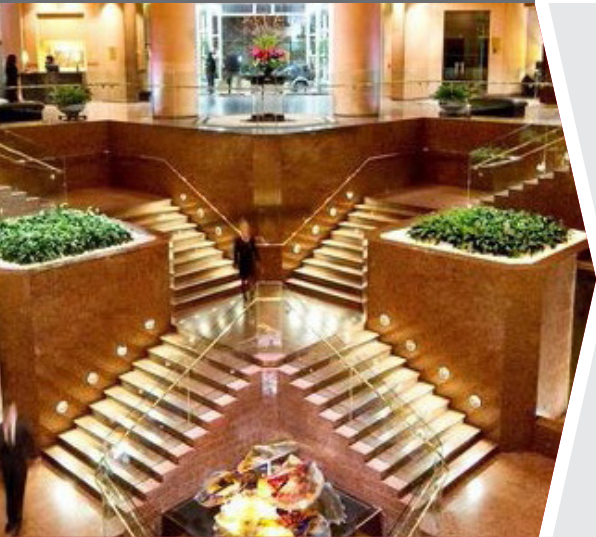

OPENING DINNER

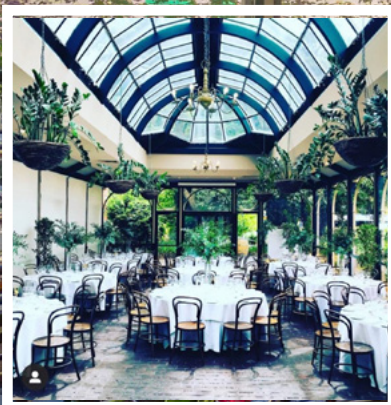
A short coach ride will take us to the beautiful Ayers House Conservatory for the official opening of the 15th Carbine Club International Congress.

OUR DAY AT THE WINERIES D'ARENBERG WINERY

McLaren Vale is home to very old vines and wineries. Our Congress Committee decided we should go to **McLaren Vale** and visit **d'Arenberg and Serafino wineries**.

d'Arenberg Winery is a comfortable 45 minute drive from Adelaide. Family owned for more than a century, it is the pride and joy of the Osborn Family. These days the winemaking and business management is in the hands of **Chester Osborn** but his father **d'Arry** is never more than a few steps away.

One can only describe Chester Osborn as a real character. He is zany; colourful; brilliant; humorous – all wrapped up in the one bundle. This is best exemplified by his recent creation – **The Cube** (picture below). This is a living wine museum like no other in this country, or dare we say the world.

Chester will be on hand as we are shown around this amazing structure. We will be treated to a tasting of their famous wines (including the legendary Dead Arm Shiraz).

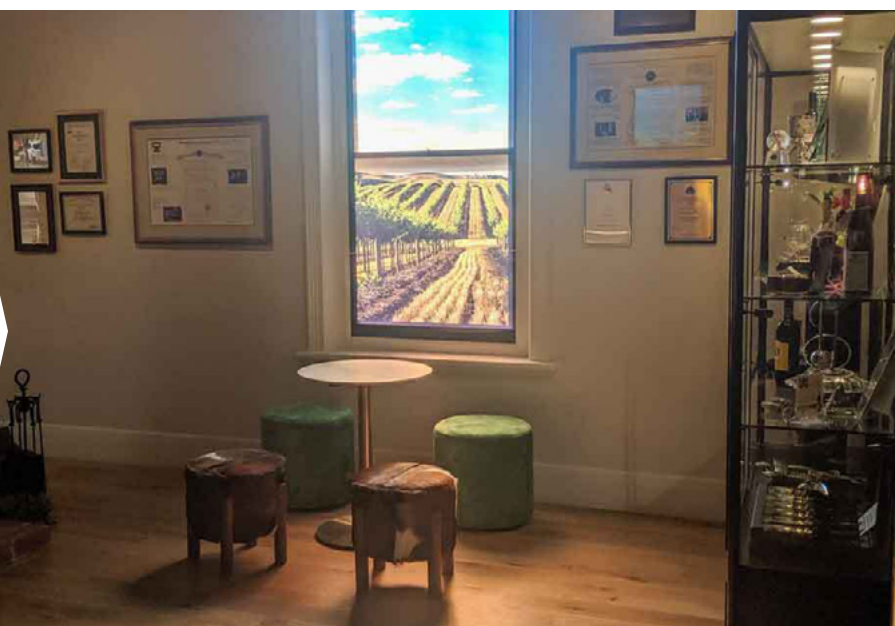


THE WOLF BLASS WINE MUSEUM

Carbine Club of South Australia has negotiated to defer major deposits until end of January 2022 by which time we are confident Australian States will be on board with National Covid-safe plans. In the event the Congress is cancelled the Carbine Club of South Australia is confident of being able to refund a majority of the deposit paid by delegates.

Carbine Club of South Australia recommend all delegates have full Covid Vaccination prior to attending the Congress and consider taking out a Travel Insurance Policy.

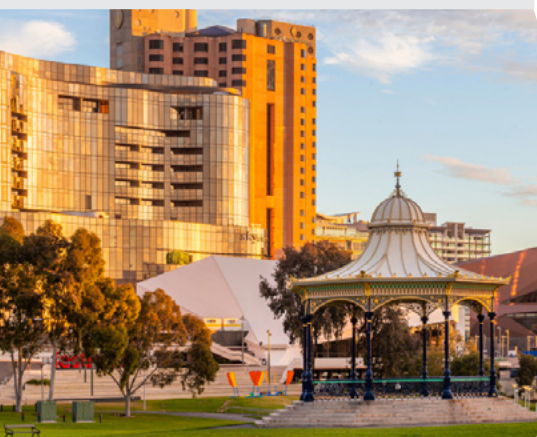
